In other words- He was going to obey His Mom- and they could obey Him.


I see a great lack of respect for Mom today. I hear children scolding their Mom. I see children hitting their Mom. I watch children mock their Mom.

2022 CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Our 3-year "Do Not Grow Weary" Capital Campaign began November 6, 2022.

Committed \$192,099.94 Monthly Payment \$6,366.88 Current Debt \$536,938.45 Amount Given as of 04/30/24 \$111,620.00

We still have some items that need completion to meet Fire Department requirements. These include ceiling grid and tiles in a couple of rooms, baseboard trim, mounting a fire extinguisher in the kitchen (we have it, it just needs to be mounted), finishing the showers, and some plumbing work (this requires a licensed plumber). If you are willing to help with some of these, let me or Pastor Jon know.

If you are led to contribute financially, simply mark "Building Fund" on the memo line of your check or put it in a giving envelope and write the amount next to "Building Fund."
